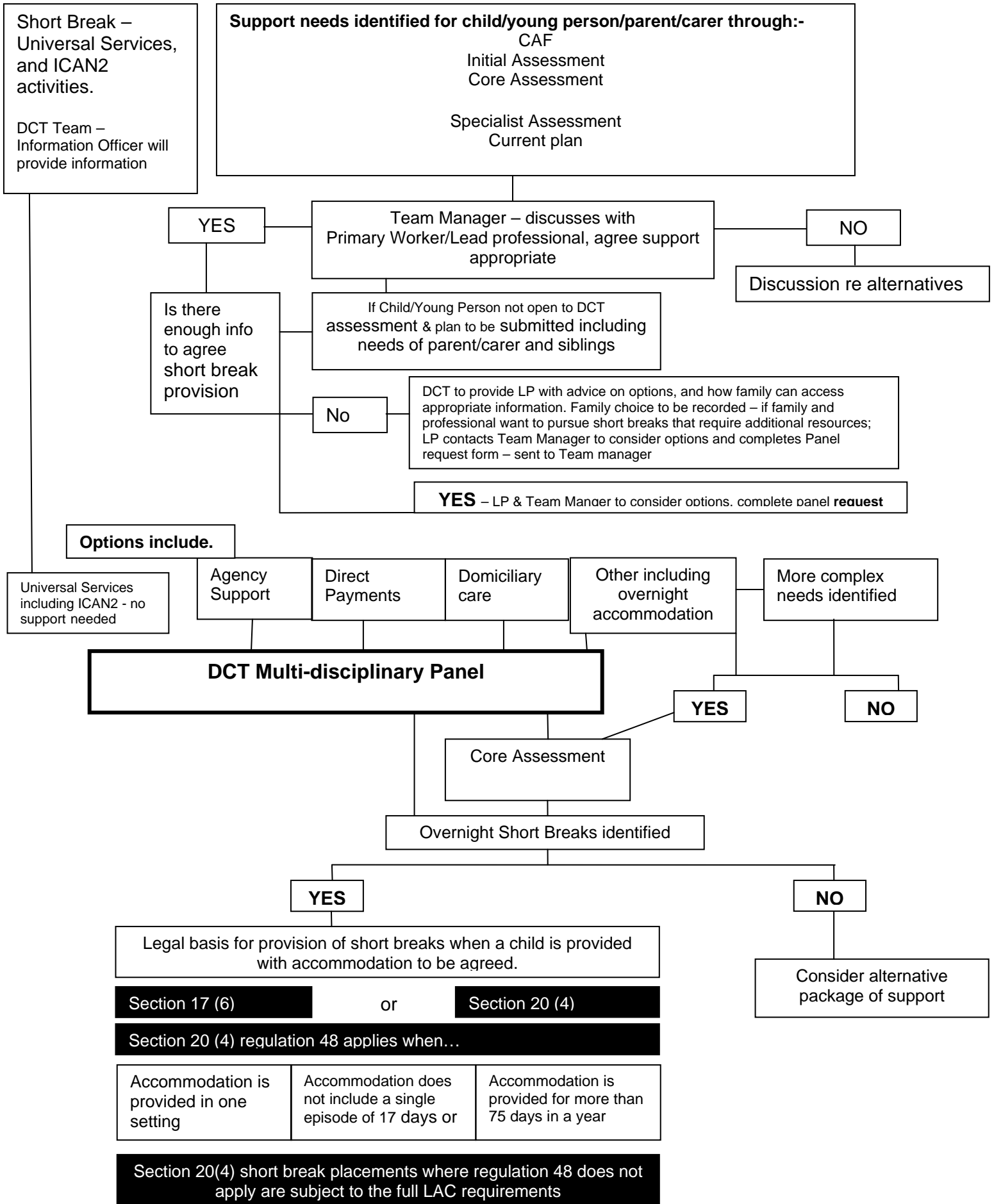


Flow Chart – Access to Short Break provision



Short Break – Universal Services, and ICAN2 activities.

DCT Team – Information Officer will provide information

Support needs identified for child/young person/parent/carer through:-
CAF
Initial Assessment
Core Assessment
Specialist Assessment
Current plan

Team Manager – discusses with Primary Worker/Lead professional, agree support appropriate

Discussion re alternatives

Is there enough info to agree short break provision

If Child/Young Person not open to DCT assessment & plan to be submitted including needs of parent/carer and siblings

DCT to provide LP with advice on options, and how family can access appropriate information. Family choice to be recorded – if family and professional want to pursue short breaks that require additional resources; LP contacts Team Manager to consider options and completes Panel request form – sent to Team manager

YES – LP & Team Mander to consider options. complete panel request

Options include.

Universal Services including ICAN2 - no support needed

Agency Support

Direct Payments

Domiciliary care

Other including overnight accommodation

More complex needs identified

Legal basis for provision of short breaks when a child is provided with accommodation to be agreed.

Section 17 (6)

or

Section 20 (4)

Section 20 (4) regulation 48 applies when...

Accommodation is provided in one setting

Accommodation does not include a single episode of 17 days or

Accommodation is provided for more than 75 days in a year

Section 20(4) short break placements where regulation 48 does not apply are subject to the full LAC requirements

Consider alternative package of support
