Aims of the ELSEC Programme

The overall aim of ELSEC is to improve the speech and language offer for all children in Early Years and into Key Stage 1.

- Improve early identification and support CYP with SLCN support.
- Build upon what settings are already doing to promote SLC and explore different ways of promoting SLC in the Early Years and KS1.
- Increase workforce capacity.
- Provide additional interventions, gather high quality data and evidence to inform future programmes.
- Co-production and joined up working between education, health and parents.
- Reduce the need for specialist referrals.



The ELSEC offer

As part of the ELSEC offer a range of FREE services are given to settings.

All settings are supported with the training and delivery of Talk Boost – EY and KS1.

ELSEC includes:

- Each setting to have a dedicated ELSEC practitioner and named ELSEC lead.
- Meeting with setting leaders to identify individual setting needs.
- Modelling and coaching for setting staff.
- A communication audit.
- Workshops for parents.
- Bespoke training to meet the needs of individual settings.

Timescales

Data will be collected for the DfE until August 2025 although currently we will continue to work with settings until 2026.
